Cloudvue Gateway Quickstart Guide

1. PLUG THE GATEWAY INTO YOUR NETWORK

Connect an Ethernet cable from a router which has access to the Internet to **PORT #1** on the back of the Gateway. If you are using a PoE switch for your cameras, plug that into **PORT #2** on the back of the Gateway and then plug your cameras into the PoE switch.

2. GET THE CLOUDVUE MOBILE APP

Install the Cloudvue mobile app, get it for free from the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store. If you already have a Cloudvue account, click **LOGIN**. If you do not, click on **CREATE ACCOUNT**.

3. REGISTER THE GATEWAY

In the Cloudvue mobile app, click on the + sign in the upper right corner. Click on **ADD CLOUD GATEWAY**. Enter a **NAME** for the gateway then click on **SCAN BARCODE** to scan the MAC address of the gateway or manually type it in. Then click on the **ADD** button.

4. LOGIN ONLINE

Go to: www.cloudvue.ai from your web browser (Google Chrome preferred) and click on **LOGIN** then click on **CLOUDVUE**. Login with the same credentials as the mobile app.

5. ADD CAMERAS

Once logged in, click on **SETTINGS** and then click on **DEVICES**, then click on **SCAN FOR DEVICES**. The system will automatically find any compatible cameras on your network, click on the **ADD** button to add them to the Gateway.
