

Identifying the Motherboard Installed in an exacqVision System (Windows)

To determine the make and model of the motherboard installed in an exacqVision system, complete the following steps:

- 1. Click Start, type cmd, and press Enter to open a Command Prompt.
- 2. Type **systeminfo** and press Enter to display information about the motherboard.



3. Find the **System Manufacturer** and **System Model** entries. (In the preceding example, the motherboard is a Precision M6600 from Dell Inc.)

NOTE: If necessary, maximize the window or scroll up to display the full list.
